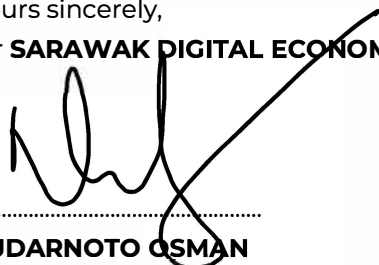

TERM OF REFERENCE: REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR SUPPLY, END USER TRAINING AND LOGISTICS OF IT HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE.

1. General Information

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is issued to provide the selection process for the **SUPPLY, END USER TRAINING AND LOGISTICS** services for the project named above.

Sarawak Digital Economy Corporation Berhad (SDEC) is a company wholly owned by the Sarawak Government through State Financial Secretary Inc. under the Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning which has been entrusted as the implementing agency to drive the Sarawak Digital Economy initiatives.

2. Project Description

To provide and manage the supply, end user training and logistic of both hardware and software throughout Sarawak to selected participants.

3. Scope of Work

- 3.3. Providing a quotation for the end user basic training and certified training (if any) for each equipment quoted.
- 3.4. Supplying of equipment for both hardware and software based on the specifications requested.
- 3.5. Manage the logistics by delivering the equipment throughout Sarawak and liaising with the MSMEs for the logistics of the equipment
- 3.6. Providing the end user training based on the equipment quoted.

- 3.7. Managing the maintenance based on the warranty provided.
- 3.8. Liaising with all relevant authorities, and other parties needed for the completion of the above scope of work.
